

**Food Stand
Of Wooden Kitchens and Sausages**

Manufacturer: Achtendung Company, Cologne

Year of construction: around the 1930s

This former "Wurstbraterei" is one of the last remaining wooden snack bars in the Rhineland. It has a typical built-in wooden sausage kitchen.

These types of stalls bore the name of their function or main product. It was painted in large letters on the edges of the roof. Above this, often on a rounded surface, was the name of the owner. The booths were usually painted white. The posts, rafters and framing, on the other hand, were coloured.

The Wurstbraterei of the Vosen family shown here became part of the open-air museum's inventory in 2015. The original signs on the roof edges could be preserved on the left side and the back. The signs on the show sides have been replaced.
