

Pneumatically Driven Flying Merry-Go-Round A Journey Into the Air

In the early 1950s, technical innovations led to the further development of rides. Previously unknown ride experiences were now possible due to pneumatics and hydraulics.

After World War II, rides that had been rescued or repaired were operated. It was only with the advent of pneumatics and hydraulics that the rides entered a new era with innovative movement sequences.

In 1951, the first pneumatic ride was manufactured in Germany by the company "Fahrzeug- und Maschinenfabrik Klaus" in Memmingen. For the first time, passengers could determine the flight height of their gondolas themselves.
